Advice Letter No. 143

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

DEL ORO WATER COMPANY

Del Oro Water Company on behalf of its Pine Flat District (DOWCPF) hereby transmits for filing, in accordance with California Public Utilities Commission Resolution No. W-4327 authorizing the recovery of annual EPA required costs, the following changes in its tariff schedules which are attached hereto:

The present metered rates for DOWCPF became effective on September 6, 2005, pursuant to Resolution No. W-4558.

Assembly Bill 2995, in adding section 4019.10 to the California Health and Safety Code, directs the Department of Health Services (DHS) to charge the utilities within its jurisdiction for all operating costs. The legislation also authorized these costs to be passed on to those utilities' customers. Commission Resolution W-4327, March 6, 2002, authorizes PFWC to file the attached rate schedule, and to concurrently withdraw and cancel its present schedules for such service.

DOWCPF has the required Water Quality Memorandum Account (WQMA) and recorded therein the amount of \$2,895.00 representing expenses resulting from drinking water regulations, including water sampling, testing, reporting, and treatment costs paid by DOWCPF.

DOWCPF requests permission to recover the above charges from its 153 customers by adding an annual one-time surcharge of \$14.475, collected over three billing cycles at \$4.825 per month, to each customer's bill. Back up documentation as well as an earnings test are enclosed as attachments to this advice letter.

There are two ways to respond to this notice. You can send a protest to the CPUC and, if you do, you must send a copy of the protest to the utility; or you can send a response to the CPUC with a copy to the utility if you wish. A protest is a document objecting to the granting in whole or in part of the authority sought in this advice letter. A response is a document that does not object to the authority sought, but nevertheless presents information that the party tendering the response believes would be useful to the Commission in acting on the request. A protest must be mailed within 20 days of the date the California Public Utilities Commission accepts the advice letter for filing served on the utility. The filing date is the date the advice letter was put on the Commission Calendar. The Calendar is available at the Commission's website, www.cpuc.ca.gov. A protest must state the facts on which the protest is based, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant, and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter, or a part of it, is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter. The utility must respond to a protest within five days.
